Dr Pramod Moghe sensitized them about the risks associated with consuming impure water and methods of purification. Overall he provided guidance on chemical free living.

Ms Shailaja Deshpande and Ms Mrunal Vaidya demonstrated how farmers can save their monthly expenses by making home-made personal hygiene products. There was enthusiastic participation from all the participants in this activity.

Mr Niranjana Upasani shared how farmers could create other avenues of income by making products using farm waste or locally available trees, herbs and fruits. He also encouraged farmers to locally produce all items required for their day to day consumption. Participants were also provided guidance around how they could market their produce.

Trustees of Manavlok were present during the event at Ambejogai. Mr Surykant Kulkarni, founder of Swapnabumi attended the workshop at Kerwadi and provided guidance to the participants.
